SCIENCE OLYMPIAD

Teams compete in 23 different events from Astronomy to Robotics. Three different types of events are offered: build events in which you design, construct, and operate a device; study events in which you prepare reference materials for a test; and laboratory events in which you work in a lab setting.



SCIENCE BOWL

Do you like rapid trivia-style games? If so, Science Bowl is for you. Students work in teams to buzz in and answer questions on a variety of science topics including: biology, chemistry, physics, geology, astronomy, math, environmental science, and energy.



NATIONAL OCEAN SCIENCES BOWL

NOSB is also a quiz bowl type of tournament. The questions, however, are on topics that involve the ocean: oceanography, marine biology, and environmental science of the oceans.
